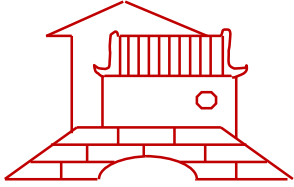

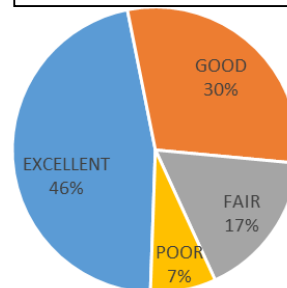

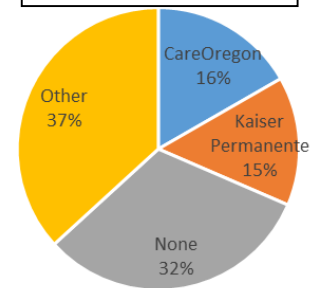

This year health providers connected with members in person by answering insurance benefits questions, scheduling doctor visits, and helping navigate the health care system. The event is an astonishing collaborative community effort. We are pleased to have served the Asian communities with efficacy thanks to the volunteers who assisted with interpreting and ensuring that community members were well taken care of. Special thanks to the support from *Linguava and Passport to Languages* for providing over 35 interpreters for the day.

- 1,700-2,000 estimated total people attended

  - 23% Vietnamese
  - 14% Korean
  - 6 % Other
- 170+ provider volunteers
- 105+ bilingual volunteers
- 2,200+ health screenings/services
